DECISION ON COSTS

ADDERLEY, JA

- [1]. We have considered on the papers the Respondents' written Submissions on Costs filed 9 September 2020, the Appellant's Response filed 10 September, and the Respondents' Reply filed 11 September 2020. Although the issues to be decided affected the Respondents personally, they were of general public importance, particularly the construction of Regulation 4(6). In all the circumstances it was not unreasonable to seek the determination of the Courts on the issues and this would point to an exception to the general rule that costs follow the event. We find support for this view in the decisions from the Caribbean, South Africa and England and order that each party bear its own costs of the appeal.
- [2]. With respect to Mr Mitchell QC's application for costs below, there is no record that the Judge made an order as to costs and there is no record of an appeal on that point. We see no reason to make such an order now.
